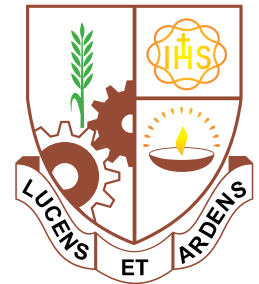

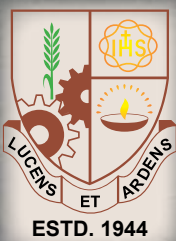

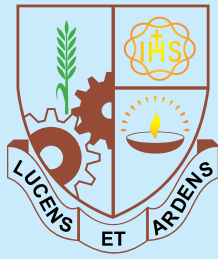

ADMISSION PROCESS UG/PG

(Instruction and Guidelines for Online Application)

General Information:

1. The UG courses shall be of duration of three years (Six Semesters) and PG courses shall be of two years (Four Semesters).
2. Candidates may apply for more than one subject separately through the online application process. The payment is to be made separately for each application.
3. A Candidate must fulfill the eligibility criteria in order to get admission in any programme/subject. Subject-wise Eligibility Criteria is mentioned below. Please read it carefully before you apply for it.
4. A Candidate with compartmental results or with failure in any subject should not apply.
5. The number of seats in any programme is fixed.

1	English	50% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate for Arts with 50% marks in English. 55% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate for Science and Commerce.
2	Hindi	50% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate for Arts with 50% marks in Hindi. 55% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate for Science and Commerce.
3	Geography	50% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate for Arts with 50% marks in Geography. 55% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate for Science and Commerce.
4	History	50% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate for Arts with 50% marks in History. 55% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate for Science and Commerce.
5	Political Science	50% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate for Arts with 50% marks in Political Science. 55% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate for Science and Commerce.
6	Sociology	50% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate for Arts with 50% marks in Sociology. 55% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate for Science and Commerce.
7	Economics	50% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate for Arts with 50% marks in Economics. 55% aggregate marks in +2/ Intermediate for Science & Commerce. At least pass marks in Mathematics paper is mandatory for all in +2/Intermediate.

1	Physics	50% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate (Science) with PCM. 50% marks in Physics with at least 45% marks in Mathematics.
2	Mathematics	50% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate (Science) with PCM. 50% marks in Mathematics.
3	Chemistry	50% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate (Science) with PCM/PCB. 50% marks in Chemistry.
4	Botany	50% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate (Science) with PCB. 50% marks in Biology.
5	Zoology	50% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate (Science) with PCB. 50% marks in Zoology.
6	Geology	50% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate (Science) with PCM/PCB.
7	Statistics	50% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate (Science) with PCM. 50% marks in Mathematics.

S.No.	Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.)	Eligibility Criteria
1	B.Com. (Accounts Hons.)	50% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate (Commerce/Science). 50% marks in Accounts at +2/Intermediate is mandatory. Also 50% marks in Business Studies/Commerce is mandatory.

3	Journalism and Mass Communication	50% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate (Arts). 55% marks in +2/Intermediate (Science/Commerce)

S.No.	Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) Self-Financed	Eligibility Criteria
1	Biotechnology	50% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate (Science) with PCB
2	Computer Application (CAPP)	50% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate (Science) Maths with at least 45% marks is compulsory for CAPP. Students should have personal laptops/computer.
3	Information Technology (IT)	50% aggregate marks in +2/Intermediate (Science) Maths with at least 45% marks is compulsory for IT. Students should have personal laptops/computer.
